- E. Electromagnetic noise and interference
- F. Wave propagation and remote sensing
- G. Ionospheric radio and propagation
- H. Waves in plasmas
- J. Radio astronomy
- K. Electromagnetics in biology and medicine

No Registration Fees

A special graduate student session will host a limited number of presentations and posters presenting MSc/PhD research work, **without registration fees**. Best papers and best student papers will be selected by the organizing committee for awards.
